



**Les Murakami Stadium: Baseball
Emergency Action Plan**

Emergency Personnel: Certified Athletic Trainer, Athletic Training Student(s) on site for practice and competitions; coaches, additional sports medicine staff accessible from athletic training facilities or other adjacent venues.

Emergency Communication:

- Cellular Telephone
- Fixed Telephone line in Les Murakami Stadium Athletic Training Room
(808) 956-9815
- Pay Telephones: These phones are located across from the main entrance of Les Murakami Stadium next to the doors leading to each dugout tunnel.

Emergency Equipment: supplies (AED, spine board, and trauma kit) transported to and maintained in the Les Murakami Stadium Athletic Training Room.

Role of First Responders:

- Immediate care of the injured or ill student-athlete
- Emergency equipment retrieval
- Activation of the emergency medical system
 - **Call 911** (provide name, address, telephone number, number of individuals injured, condition of injured, first aid treatment administered, specific directions, other information as requested.)
 - **DO NOT HANG UP UNTIL EMS HANGS UP**
 - Notify campus security at **x6-6911**.
- Direct EMS to scene
 - Open appropriate gates/doors
 - Designate individual to “flag down” EMS and direct to scene
 - Scene Control: limit scene to first aid providers and move bystanders away from area.

Venue Directions: EMS personnel are to be directed to enter from the Dole Street entrance.

When coming from King Street go North on University Avenue. Turn right at Dole Street across from Bachman Hall. Turn right at the first stop light onto Lower Campus Road. Drive through the guard booth and proceed towards the Stan Sheriff Arena. Drive past the Stan Sheriff Arena and follow the road. Turn left into the first base line parking lot and enter the stadium through the gates near the first base bull pen.
