- I. Emergency Personnel/Team
 - a. Doctor(s)
 - b. Athletic Trainers
 - c. EMT/MICT
 - d. Administrators
 - e. Coaches
 - f. NBC staff

- II. Role of the Emergency Team
 - a. Establish the scene is safe and immediate care of athletes
 - b. Activation of Emergency Medical System (EMS)
 - c. Emergency equipment retrieval (i.e. AED, Spine Board, Splints, etc.)
 - d. Directions for EMS to the scene
 - e. Unlock all appropriate gates, doors and locks, etc.

- III. Emergency Equipment (in temporary athletic training room)
 - a. AED
 - b. Spine Board
 - c. Splint kit, Crutches, etc.
 - d. Athletic training kits
 - e. Ice

- IV. Emergency Communication
 - a. Making the Call
 - 1. Cell phone to EMS by athletic trainer
 - 2. Host Athletic trainer contacts NBC staff of EMS call
 - 3. Notify tournament director or host AD
 - b. Caller provides EMS with:
 - 1. Location of injured athlete
 - 2. EMS to enter through Kapiolani gate
 - 3. Nature of emergency
 - 4. Number of people injured
 - 5. Condition of injured
 - 6. First aid treatment rendered
 - 7. Other information requested

- V. Role of NBC Staff
 - a. Open Kapiolani Gate and flag down EMS
 - b. Unlock roll-up door
 - c. Secure path for EMS arrival to back gate
 - d. Secure scene to only EMS and athletic trainers

- VI. Role of First Responder

- a. Immediate care of injured athlete/individual(s)
- b. Activate EMS
 1. Call 911
 2. Notify host athletic trainer and host athletic trainer notifies tournament director.
- c. Stabilize athlete until EMS arrives
